Care and cleaning instructions for Dickson Marine Fabrics.

Step 1

Brush off any loose dirt.

Step 2

Clean fabric with a mixture of warm water and a mild detergent mixed in a gallon of water. Use a 2" soft bristle nylon brush to gently scrub.

Step 3

Rinse Dickson Acrylic thoroughly with plenty of cool water. Continue to rinse until all soap residues are gone.

Step 4

Apply an air-curing fluorocarbon water repellent treatment. Do this if water repellency is an issue.

Note

Do not use a pressure washer to clean Dickson Fabrics. This could damage the acrylic.
